in dummy. The heart 9 would be
equally bad, setting up the 8,
which he knew South held. So he
threw off the club Q, hoping his
partner had the 10. South, of
course, put dummy's club 8 on
this, then led the club 10. West
was squeezed again. Once more he
had to hold the heart 9, so put on
the spade Q, hoping his partner
had the J. But South did, led it to
the A to drop the K and finished
with the spade 10, making his con-
tract. The saddest thing, from
West's viewpoint, is that the post-
mortem showed his opponents
could have been chastised if they
took out a double of No Trumps
into diamonds.
