For the second month in succession, Henderson had no fire loss during July, according to the monthly report of Fire Chief Cooper Ellis today. There was not even a call to firemen from within the city limits.

Two calls from outside were received, both of them being tires. One was an automobile, with damage so slight that it was not reportable, and the other was a roof fire with \$25 damage list-

Fire loss for seven months of 1941 amounted to \$1.344 in 35 actual fires out of a total of 41 calls. For the first seven months of 1940, the city had a fire loss of \$1.506 in 28 small fires, with a total of 52 calls to firemen.
