Funeral services will be held on Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock.

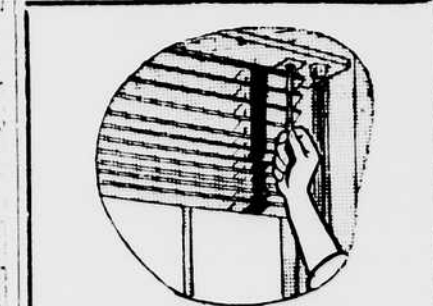
TRAFFIC FINE Turner Wortham paid \$1 into the city clerk's office today for a traffic law violation, records there showed today.
