Western Hemisphere solidarity, carried to its logical and finest conclusion, would encompass a program that would kick out all unnaturalized and many naturalized and menacing Germans and Japanese.

Almost forty million men have been enrolled in the four registrations already held. This is more than could possibly be used in the war effort, but there is no thought of undertaking to use all of them.

Significance of the new presidential edict, coupled with similar enactments before this, should have an ominous effect in Tokyo and Berlin. If it means anything, it surely means that the United States is not playing ball this time and is no kidding. The nation is in this fight to achieve final and complete victory.

The whole motley mess is repugnant to the American mind and make-up. But there will be no shirking on that account. Folks at whom these menacing moves are aimed are the ones who started this thing, though the United States and its allies will claim the privilege of finishing it and in a manner that will not be pleasing, not even a little, to warring disturbers of the peace of the world.

Without hope humanity would be lost in an abyss of despair. But there is hope, and there is likewise the privilege of expectation. There is also an old adage that is packed to the brim with wisdom.

Best authorities say the German war machine is capable of at least one more terrific wallop. That wallop might prove effective and might succeed. And if it did, it would be just too bad.

All of us believe that victory will in the end be ours. The tide has been running in our direction of life. There is the chance, however, that all this might change overnight. The war has not been won yet, and there
