Raleigh, Jan. 8. Factional politics were little in evidence in the committee assignments announced on the opening day of the senate by Lieutenant Governor Harris.

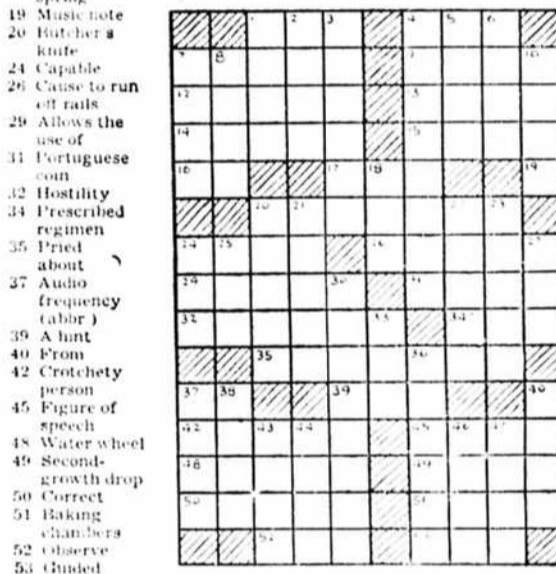
The two big committees, Finance and Appropriations, this year receive the order of priority. It was unanimously agreed that approximately 100 bills, the most important ones, be reported by H. P. (Pat) Taylor, the chief supporter of Harrison in the gubernatorial campaign.

Some observers think they can see politics in the appointment of Senator Eugene Brooks of Durham as chairman of the committee on constitutional amendments.
