#### Flying Fortresses Bomb Jap Cruiser In Rabaul Harbor

Three 500-Pounders Hit Warship; Cargo Ship Bombed and Waterfront Raked

Allied Headquarters in Australia, Feb. 21—(AP)—Dodge flying through intense anti-aircraft fire, Flying Fortress crews of General Douglas MacArthur's command dropped three 500-pound bombs on a Japanese cruiser in Rabaul harbor in New Britain yesterday and scored hits within 25 feet of a 7,000-ton cargo vessel, an Allied communiqué said today.
