CRACK NAZI UNITS FLEE BEFORE BRITISH

Allied Planes Scatter Jap Convoy

Four Ships Destroyed Or Damaged

**MacArthur's Losses
Are Light; Pursuit
Of Lae-Bound Convoy
Is Continued**

Alied Headquarters in Australia, March 3—(AP)—The crippled and widely scattered remnants of a 14-ship Japanese convoy, smashed by mixed bombers and fighters yesterday, staggered through the fog-shrouded Bismarck Sea today toward the safety of Lae, New Guinea, with General Douglas MacArthur's planes relentlessly on its trail.

At least four transports and cargo vessels of the original armada of seven Japanese warships and seven merchant ships have been sunk or damaged and 13 Japanese fighter planes out of the umbrella of 26 or 30 that tried to provide protection to the convoy have been shot out of action, allied headquarters announced.

"Our losses are light. The last estimates," headquarters commented.

Allied Flying Fortresses and Liberator bombers, with a fleet escort of P-38 fighters, shelled through murky haze, thick clouds and rain to deliver their blows in the face of heavy antiaircraft fire and Japanese fighter planes.

results of which have so far been impossible to measure," the communiqué said. Pilots reported a near miss of Japanese fighter planes.

General MacArthur's airmen also pounded Lae, bomber and attack planes punishing the air-drome area. At the same time his bombers attacked airfields on Islands northwest of Australia, destroyed an ammunition ship directly with a 500-pound bomb at Wide Bay, New Britain, and sank all the Gasmatra, New Britain, airbase in an after-dusk raid, the communiqué said.

Liberator pilots who participated in the attack on the airbase saw heavy bombs explode continually on the runway, from nests and watchtowers, in two-hour and one-and-a-half-hour intervals, with no return fire, according to reports from operating bases said.

The cost of about \$100,000 in vessels today, however, planes had quoted the convoy clinging along the New Britain coast under cover of bad weather the day before.

Local Bills Are Killed

**House Committee
Reports Unfavorably
34 Wine and Beer
Control Measures**

Raleigh, March 3—(AP)—The house finance committee did its best to hasten legislative adjournment today by reporting unfavorably on 34 local wine and beer control bills.

The measures were not needed, however, since the legislature imposed a statewide law prohibiting the sale of wine and beer from 11:30 p.m. to 7 a.m. every weekday and giving local governments the power to prohibit their sales over weekends.

Before turning to other measures, including one to give the governor far-reaching wartime powers, the house ratified the \$105,000,000 revenue bill.

The Senate kept up to the minute its work by passing 21 bills and repealing three before adjourning the 21:30 p.m. An emergency measure it passed were on fire-control and town, the power to regulate taxicab operators and to tax tobacco and to make a permanent railroad franchise in the members' nuclei.

Absenteeism Navy Is Expecting On Increase Ten Per Cent Loss

**Knox Backs Efforts
To Combat Willful
Loss of Production
In Navy Yards**

Washington, March 3—(AP)—Secretary of Navy Knox justified today he had received reports that time lost in war plants due to absenteeism was "many times greater than the time lost due to strikes or shutdowns," and that such loss of time and production had been "increasing during the past year, rather than decreasing."

Knox appeared before the House naval committee during consideration of a bill to curb absenteeism by requiring war contractors to report work absences to draft boards with the view of inducting into military service men who willfully stay away from their war production jobs.

"I wish to state to the committee," Knox said, "that whatever final form this legislation may take, I am heartily behind anything that can be done to reduce our absenteeism."

"I feel that there is a place in the whole naval establishment for a chronic absentee, and steps have already been taken to secure them from an employer after all seems have failed to cure them."
