OPA Sees New Low in Beef Supplies for Civilian Use; Other Values Change

Washington, July 2.—(AP)—The office of price administration, predicting a new low in beef supplies available for civilians in July, today increased ration values of beef cuts by another point a pound, and in a few cases two points.

The new point values of beef, which place the ration for the most popular cut from nine to 13 points, will be effective July 4.

Unless the situation changes, the new point effect will be:

In addition to the red coupon costs of veal, lamb and pork, one to two points a pound, include leg of lamb, cutlets, veal loin and ribs, and similar lamb-mutton cut.

Point values of the most popular pork cuts were not changed. Red reductions were continued for the most part to the fats, oils and dairy products groups.

Margarine and lard dropped one point—five to four—while "processed" butter, sold mainly in the South, appeared on the table for the first time at four points a pound. Regular butter remains unchanged at eight points.

Point value advances were made in seven vegetable items, and five canned bottled fruits. These increases range from about five per cent for vacuum packed whole kernel corn to over 50 per cent for tomato catsup and chili sauce. Processed foods marked up include apples, apricots, fruit cocktail, peaches, pears, fresh lima beans, canned corn, peas, tomatoes, catsup, chili sauce and tomato paste; reductions were made in fresh shelled beans, green or wax beans, tomato pulp or puree and tomato sauce.

The new "blue coupon" costs become effective July 4, and will remain valid through July.

Allied Airmen Pound 'Soft Under Belly'

Four German Planes Downed Off Africa, Axis Mediterranean Shipping Attacked

Allied Headquarters in North Africa, July 2.—(AP)—Allied airmen shot down four German fighters and slashed again at Axis Mediterranean shipping yesterday in the wake of a tire-setting attack upon barracks and railway facilities of Cagliari, Sardinia's major port, it was announced today.

The Italian communiqué said that Palermo, the Sicilian capital, was attacked again last night, and that the Axis raiders were among the numerous buildings damaged. Bombs, also were rained, it said.

A DNI dispatch broadcast from Berlin reported that United States forces reported a bombing raid against a bathing resort situated near Athens yesterday in full daylight and that 20 persons were killed and 60 injured. Allied communications did not touch upon such news.

Spotted reports of the RAF shot down the four German fighters off the coast of Africa, east. Routine sweeps and patrols were maintained from the British African bases.

Yesterday's Italian communiqué acknowledged that fires were started in Cagliari, the Sardinian capital, and several buildings in the central area of the town were said to have collapsed.

A Berlin broadcast of a DNI dispatch, recorded by the Associated Press, reported meanwhile that the heavy allied daylight attack on Palermo Wednesday had destroyed two churches and 100 houses. "The heart of the city was particularly damaged," the broadcast added.

The raid on Palermo, Sicilian capital located on the northern coast, was timed with assaults on Italian fields on Sicily. Battering attacks destroyed Palermo as about "blasted."

War Fund Bill Signed

Washington, July 2.—(AP)—\$71,500,000,000 "defense war bill" was signed into law today by President Roosevelt, giving the War Department three times as much money to spend toward victory in the next twelve months as the entire cost of the last World War to the nation.

More than \$100,000,000 is provided in the vast measure for Army aviation, including purchase of 99,749 planes.

The President acted promptly, the Senate having completed congressional action only Wednesday night.

Red Attack Shifts South

German-Occupied Ports of Crimea Are Bombed; Raids Cause Speculation

Moscow, July 2.—(AP)—Attention swung again today to the extreme southern end of the vast Russian front with Soviet disclosure that long range bombers had attacked the German-occupied ports of Kerch and Sevastopol, both on the shores of the Crimean peninsula.

Observers here attached considerable significance to this sudden shifting of the Red air force.

Kerch and Sevastopol, on the west coast of the Crimean peninsula, are the main Red air bases in the south. The German forces are now in the Crimea and the German troops on the Crimean peninsula and in the Caucasus.

British Say Nazi Industry Has Lost Production Race

London, July 2.—(AP)—Strained by nearly four years of total war and hampered day and night by allied air power, German industry has lost the production race essential to victory, although Germany still has plenty of fight left, reliable British and foreign sources indicated today.

Figures gathered by these sources suggest that Germany has positively lost her peak as a war-making machine and that the German grade of output of a production decline.
