He has said several times that the duke and duchess are children and that they are people who should be treated as such. He has said that he is a good citizen and a good neighbor.

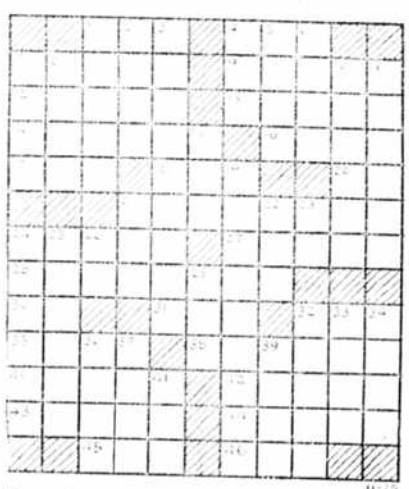
Bear Mascot for Paratroopers
