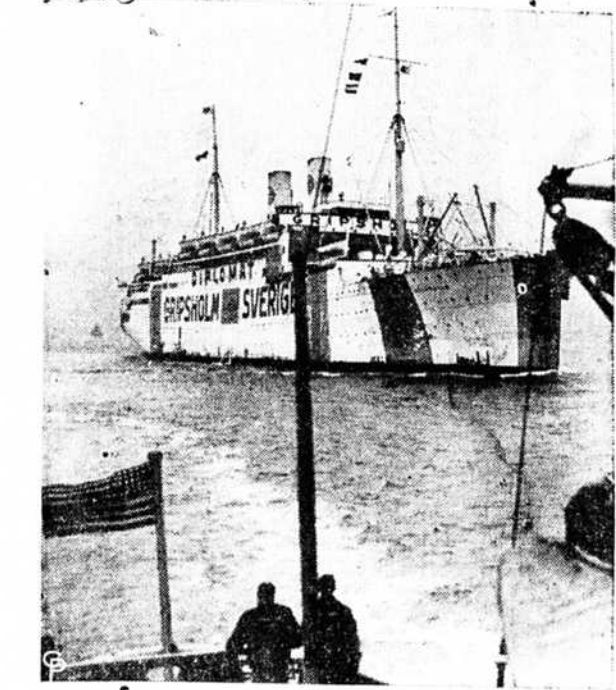


'GIVE IN OR DIE' ULTIMATUM TO GERMANY

Eighth Army Pushes On Six Miles

Allied Planes Pound On Brenner Pass and Installations Are Hit

Allied Headquarters, Algiers, Dec. 2—(AP)—Lt. Gen. Mark W. Clark's Fifth Army troops, after a long stalemate on the western Italian front, have cracked forward through machinegun-raked fields and barbed wire in the Calabritto area in the wake of a rolling barrage of artillery shells and aerial bombs.

Finland Has Decided To Continue War

Stockholm, Dec. 3—(AP)—Finland has quietly dropped the proposal that she is fighting a private war disconnected from the world conflict and apparently has decided to continue the fight against Russia as a full-fledged partner of Germany.

Two Jap Ships Sunk In Allied Bomber Actions

Southwest Pacific Allied Headquarters, Dec. 3—(AP)—Allied bombers, prowling the Pacific skies from the Marshalls to New Guinea, have sunk a troop-laden 10,000-ton Japanese transport and a larger tanker, damaged two destroyers, blasted enemy bases with more than 200 tons of bombs, and downed 21 Japanese planes in battles at both ends of the 2,000-mile arc.
