## Thousands Men Absent On War Duty

### Business Will Halt For Entire Holiday; Needy Provided For

Henderson will observe its third war Christmas tomorrow in a manner very similar to other years, yet in a sense quite different. There will be a full consciousness that a war is going on.

More than 2000 men and some women from Vance county are away from home and scattered to the four corners of the earth in the armed forces this Christmas. And many of the homes in the city and the country that will have vacant chairs at the Christmas dinner table tomorrow and on Sunday. There is not full agreement with the thought of complacency one hears so much about.

As a holiday, it will be much like Christmases before. Business will come to a full halt in practically every field, except the public service. Some establishments, as for instance the banks and city and county offices, will have a double holiday, that is, they will be closed both Saturday and Monday. Some business concerns in other fields will likewise follow this procedure, although many stores will be open

for business on Monday.

But the shutdown will be so thorough on tomorrow, Christmas day, that only the restaurants and the like will operate.

On no other day of the year is there so complete a cessation of business as on Christmas day.

No religious services will be held except at Holy Innocents Episcopal church, and the Christmas eve midnight mass at St. Paul's Catholic church.

Overcast skies may be the decree of the weather man for this section. No bitter cold is in prospect, though the mild weather of earlier in the week has largely disappeared already.

So far as has been learned, manufacturing establishments without exception will take a full holiday Saturday.

College students are at home for the holidays and will help to brighten the occasion.

Fat pay envelopes have reduced the actual need, but there have been many needy cases, and an unusually large number have been provided for already out of the generosity of abundance in many hands. Shoppers have had rather a hectic time of it, wrestling as they have with shortages and scarcities, but generally speaking Santa Claus will find his bag well filled and he will be able to remember nearly every one in more or less generous fashion.

Business concerns have had a good season, despite limitations on stocks. Prices have been high, but buyers have not held back on that account.

Christmas will be the usual gay time for the city, insofar as that is possible with so many homes where there are men and boys absent far away, men in the nation's armed forces.
