SPECIAL WARNING

To Dog Owners of Vance County

I wish to notify and warn every dog owner in Vance county of the law making it compulsory to vaccinate dogs against rabies before July 1, 1944, and of my intention to enforce this law and bring into court all persons who fail to have their dog or dogs vaccinated on or before this date. Those who fail to comply with the law will have to face a \$50.00 fine or thirty days in jail or both, in the discretion of the Court.

Dogs may be vaccinated against rabies for as little as 75¢ each, and where the dog is listed for taxes, this sum is refunded in full to the taxpayer when he pays his taxes.

I urge every dog owner in Vance county to take notice of this warning and have their dog or dogs vaccinated at once for the protection of our children and all others who are constantly coming into contact with dogs. I hope that this warning will be heeded and that it will not be necessary for my office to make a single arrest for this violation after July 1, 1944.
