Nazis Yield With Little Resistance

Port of Le Havre Virtually Doomed By Allied Advance

Supreme Headquarters, Allied Expeditionary Force, Aug. 28. (AP)—American third army tanks, in a ten mile advance, captured Meux, in the Marne river loop...

Between Paris and the English channel, Americans, British and Canadian armies threw four bridgeheads over the Seine...

The Allies also virtually doomed the great port of Le Havre, and have opened the way into the Germans' flying bomb belt farther north.

These three activities were being conducted by the Allies between Paris and the sea.

1. The British were building up a bridgehead at Vernon, 55 air line miles from the mouth of the Seine...

2. Canadian, Belgian and Dutch troops were engaged in what one observer called a "fair sized slaughter" of the enemy seventh army.

3. American troops were clearing out German stragglers in the 20-mile area between Montes and Paris.

Paris itself, where General Eisenhower was a Sunday visitor, had been cleared of the enemy except for German and Fascist French snipers.

Half of Germans Killed, Wounded or Taken Prisoners

Disorganized Nazis Bombed and Strafed By Day and Night

London, Aug. 28. (AP)—Russian troops have reached the Hungarian border, the German radio asserted tonight.

Moscow, Aug. 28. (AP)—Two great Russian army groups, paced by colorful Cossacks, advanced within less than 30 miles of Bucharest today in a drive swiftly overrunning the wealthy Ploesti oil region.

An unconfirmed report said some columns had plunged also fifty miles into Transylvania.

The 16,642 square-mile northern section of Transylvania was cut away from Romania and awarded to Hungary by Hitler in the 1940 Vienna dictate.

The German communiqué said "counter attacks by Hungarian and German troops to prevent the enemy from entering Hungary through the eastern Carpathians are making good headway."

The main Russian direction to Romania was toward Bucharest, but numerous columns moved off the Russian right flank into the Carpathians.

Strong air forces were bombing and strafing the disorganized German day and night.

Front dispatches said Nazi storm were harassing and threatening the German troops in efforts to make a stand.

There was sporadic resistance, but the second and third Ukrainian army forces appeared to have broken the back of the Nazi forces before Bucharest.

BILL WOULD INCLUDE MARITIME AND WACS

Washington, Aug. 28. (AP)—Benefits of the "G. I. Bill of Rights" would be extended to members of the merchant marine and the Women's Auxiliary Army Corps under a bill introduced today by Senator Thomas, Utah Democrat.

Bombers Hit Rocket Ramp For New V-12 Secret Plane

The Berlin radio reported Allied bombers blasted again today at Nazi Europe from Britain and Italy, striking in Germany, Austria, Hungary and Czechoslovakia.

Last night RAF Mosquitoes slashed at the Rhineland industrial center of Mannheim and attacked German transports in the Low Countries.

Heavy bombers, which have flown 3,500 sorties in large scale assaults from British and Italian bases in the past four days, were apparently idle overnight, but the fast Mosquitoes struck into Holland, bombing and strafing motor convoys and bridges, while others slashed at Mannheim.
