Turks Declare War On Germany, Japan 5,372, With Others May Follow 644 Killed

Nation Is Invited To Frisco Parley; Vote by Assembly

(By The Associated Press) Turkey declared war on Germany and Japan today, bringing several hundred thousand soldiers to the Allies' side. The declaration was announced by the Ankara radio, reporting an action of the Turkish National Assembly.

Ankara, Feb. 23.—(AP)—It was freely predicted here that a special meeting of the Turkish National Assembly this afternoon would declare war on Germany and Japan.

The Turkish government broke diplomatic and economic relations with Germany last August.

That Turkey, as well as a number of other Middle East countries, was likely to go to war against both Germany and Japan, was reported without confirmation in Cairo yesterday.

Usually reliable informants there said Lebanon, Saudi Arabia and Transjordan also would formally place themselves in the war. In London there also were rumors that Egypt might go along.
