SHOE DEALERS ARE CITED BY THE OPA

Raleigh, June 28—Twenty-nine more shoe dealers found in violation of shoe rationing regulations have been ordered to stop the sales of rationed shoes in Eastern North Carolina. It was announced today by Theodore S. Johnson, Raleigh OPA district director.

The suspensions cover periods ranging from ten days to "the duration," and affect some of the largest mercantile firms in Eastern North Carolina. The violations were chiefly in short inventory accounts of shoe coupons and shoes and the suspensions were ordered by Daniel L. Bell, chief OPA hearing commissioner of Atlanta. In all cases except one, which runs for the duration, part of the suspension is made inactive, thus putting the dealer on probation for the duration of rationing.

JUNE 30 DEADLINE SLAUGHTER PERMITS

June 30 is the deadline for farmers to obtain a slaughterer's permit from the War Price and Rationing board, the board reminded them today.

Any farmer who intends to slaughter meat to sell or give away to individuals, restaurants or stores at any time during the next year must obtain a permit, the board stated. The permit gives him a quota, telling him how much he is allowed to slaughter during the year. A farmer who will slaughter meat for his own use only does not have to obtain a permit.

The local board is prepared to register farm slaughterers and to give any information concerning the transfer of the meat, the number of pounds to be collected and the prices to charge. No permits can be granted after June 30, the board reminded farmers.

AUTO TAX STAMPS DUE BY JULY ONE

Federal auto use tax stamps are now on sale at post offices, and must be purchased and attached to windshields of automobiles on or before July 1, under Federal statute, according to Charles H. Robertson, collector of internal revenue for North Carolina. The stamp costs \$5, as has been the case since it was first required four years ago.

Robertson emphasized that the use tax law has not been repealed, and warned motorists to display the stamp on and after next Sunday. Failure to do so subjects violators to severe penalties imposed by law, he said.

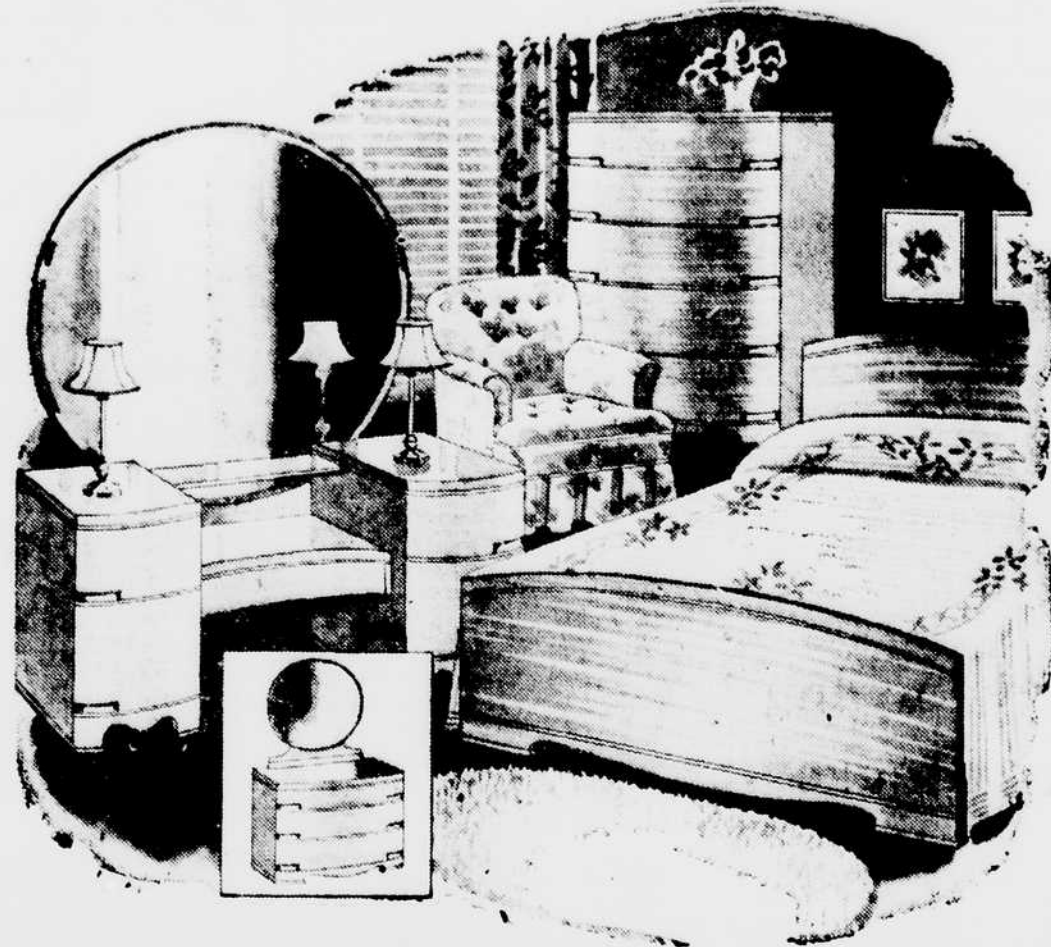

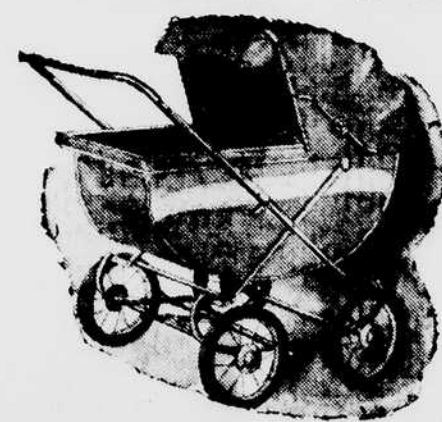

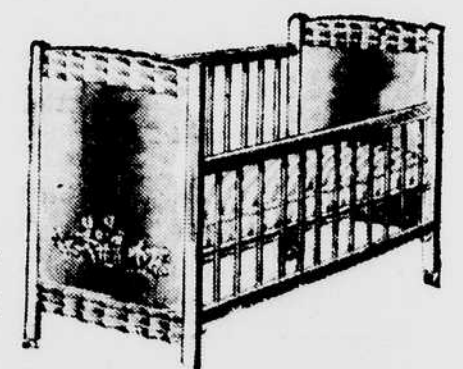
