## BARCLAY ON BRIDGE

### PROBABLY HAS ENTRIES

WHEN A PLAYER with sound habits leads the fourth-best of a suit against your No Trump game contract, he will practically always have some re-entries to bring in the remainder of the suit if they get established. Lacking high cards for re-entry, such a leader will often prefer a short-suit lead in the hope of hitting his partner's long suit. Hence, when a fourth-best is led, the declarer generally should count that player for holding high cards which are important to the hand.

North East South West  
1 ♠ Pass 1 NT Pass

South, with hardly more than barely enough to make his first bid of 1-No Trump, rated his playing ability, or luck, or something, pretty highly to justify his raise to game. But he made it pay by counting on West to hold every vital high card after the lead of the heart 2.

After East put in the Q, South

was ever more determined to treat that worthy's hand as lacking important cards, though he might have secondary ones. After winning the first trick with the heart K, he applied his formula pronto, leading to the club A and bringing back the 3, on which he played the 10, reckoning West as a probable holder of the K, but maybe not the J. When that forced the K, he scored one for his judgment.

West took the heart A, then returned the 9 to the J. Next South led toward the diamond K. Strong enough. West used the A, raised in the heart 3, then led the diamond 3. The K won, luckily dropping the Q, so the contract was made, by aid of the spade finesse. Of course, if West played low on the first diamond, South would have been in a corner. But his skill with luck had prevailed.
