BARCLAY ON BRIDGE

HIGH CARDS NOT ALL MANY PLAYERS bid as if showing their high card strength is practically the only factor of any importance. If one bid would give a clearer picture of their total honor power, they prefer it without even considering that some other bid would enable their partners to know more about their suit lengths. A response of 2-No Trumps to an opening suit call is one of their favorite measures, in cases where a finer player would rather bid a suit and thus help the side hunt for a better declaration.

North took a two-trick beating in his No Trump game contract at Table 1 of the duplicate where this hand was dealt. East led a spade and made it impossible for the declarer to take nine tricks before losing to the heart A, whereupon spade tricks plus one in diamonds settled his hash. He would have

gone down only one if he had driven to the heart A before touching diamonds, but never could have made his game. At tables where North responded with hearts, either on his first turn or his second--or both, as occurred at Table 2--the side went after a heart game, which was airtight against any defense, plus a couple of extra tricks. Nothing was lost except a trick to the heart A. With a situation on which a slam was so easy to make, you would think somebody would find the way to bid it--perhaps through North using the Blackwood convention to probe for aces and kings after the heart fit was shown, or else by either just bidding the slam himself or inviting it with 5-Hearts. But at all the 12 tables, nobody reached it, though every heart declarer took 12 tricks. All No Trump declarers were set either one or two.
