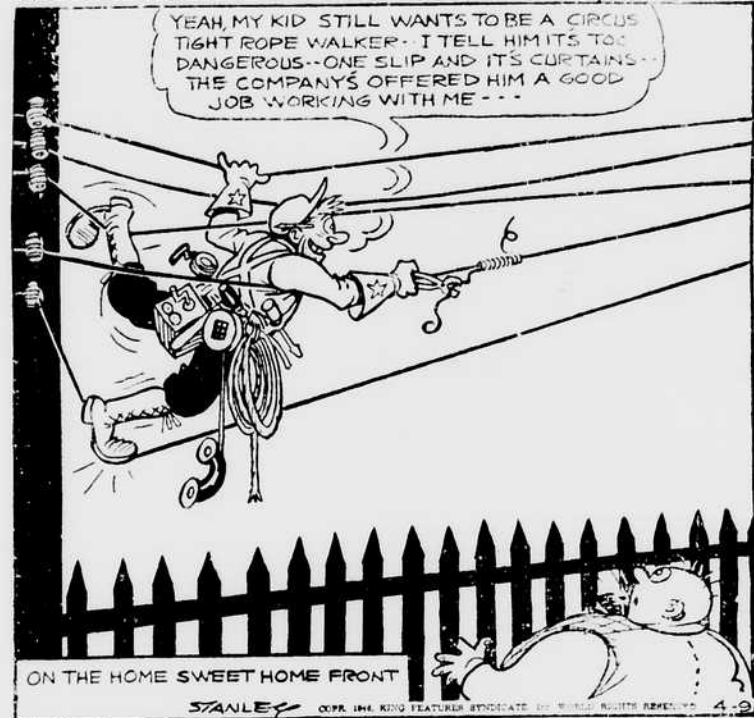

The sun's spots are again inter-fering with telegraphic communication. Gosh, how we wish the old busy-body would get off the line.



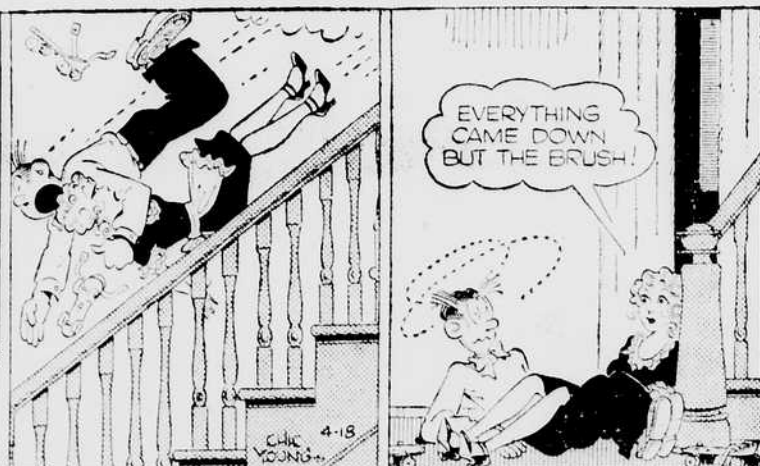
