-Around Capital Square-

Raleigh, June 11.—A group of men around the capitol were discussing the success of the Democratic ticket in the recent Italian elections which resulted in a good majority against continuing the monarchy and

the House of Savoy royal rulers. "Yep," said one of the fellows, "The Italians have proven their capacity for Democratic self government. Didn't you see that story in the paper this morning about the losing side charging the winners with fraud in the election? That's just the way the traditional Democrats in North Carolina do — especially in the fifth district." The others in the group agreed that in this respect at least the Italians seemed to qualify as Democrats.

C. P. A. — One of the chief topics for discussion at the state convention of certified public accountants in Raleigh next week (June 20-22) will be the increasing number of tax fraud cases. Unprecedented income during the war boom years, following less times for many business firms, led to some short cuts in income tax returns. Also the rapidity with which regulations were changed occasioned many errors to be made through sheer ignorance of new requirements. The federal government has been going after violators with more than usual vigor during recent months. A number of special agents have been added to the enforcement staff in this as well as other states.

AUTHORITY — In order to get the latest authoritative data on federal tax practice and policy the accountants have invited J. G. Korner, chief of the tax court at Washington, to make one of the principal speeches at their meeting. Korner is a native North Carolinian, a former chairman of the tax board of appeals, and a recognized authority on the whole subject of federal taxation. He will speak Friday afternoon, June 21, and a number of business men who are not members of the association have been invited to hear him.

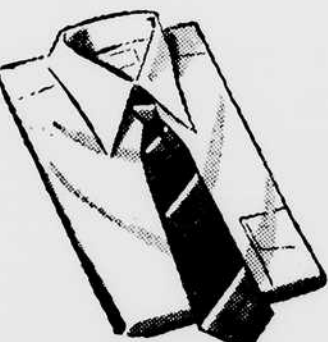

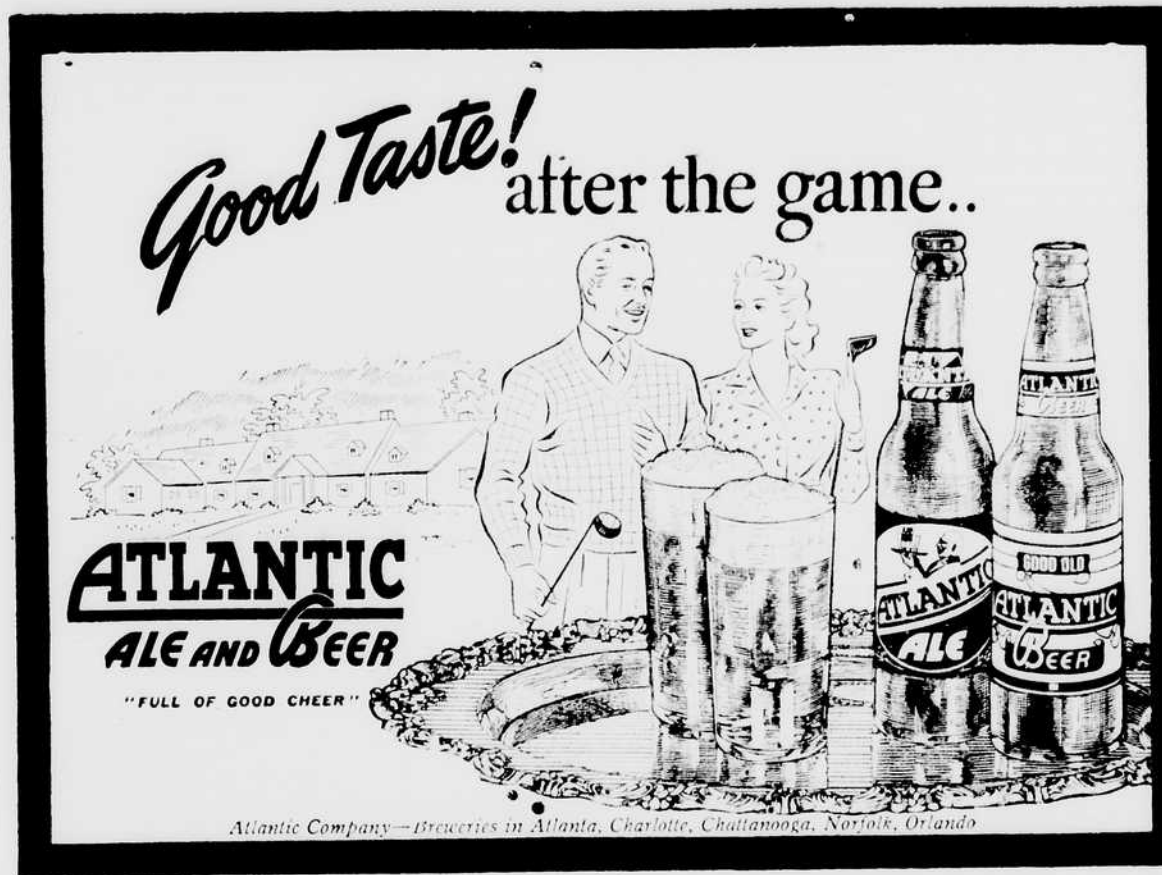
