MR. BRYAN'S CAMPAIGN.

DEMOCRATIC LEADER PROMPTLY ANSWERS QUESTIONS.

One of His Questioners Has a Sad Escape from Lynching Before a Democratic Presidential Candidate Could Answer Great Mass Listen to the Great Champion of the Democratic Party in Chicago.

Chicago, November 2.—W. J. Bryan, orator in Chicago today surprised twelve speakers. The crowd that greeted him was greater than those at the meetings of yesterday a last night. The candidate began his oration at Hanley Hall, in the downtown business district, riding from the public library, where he spoke to an outdoor gathering of working men. After his speech he made his address in "Old Milwaukee" pavilion, Sixteenth street and College Grove, in one to the crowd in the building and the other to the others that were unable to gain admittance. Here was the only semblance of disturbance manifested during the day. Two men in the audience acted almost simultaneously. "Here comes North Carolina," and Mr. Bryan was repaid when one of the 3000 here insisted on asking a question concerning the movement toward the nomination of Bryan. He had no time to answer, however, as he could not get some time to speak to the upsurge by the crowd, so continuing his movement toward the auditorium. A man who had been here only a few minutes before Mr. Bryan's speech, and who had been shouting all day, was he held in check by the chairman of the campaign committee, the chairman of the platform committee, and the chairman of the finance committee.

At the close of the oration Bryan was evidently too tired to speak again. "I want to tell you that I Republican party is eager to maintain its position on the question of imperialism, and every instrument, every device we have been taught to hold dear, we have tried to work wonders for the cause of Bryan."
