History of North Carolina.

Capt. S. A. Ashe to Publish Such a Work in Two Volumes.

Capt. S. A. Ashe has been engaged the past three years on an extensive and complete history of North Carolina, and the reading public will be glad to learn that the first volume will be ready for distribution some time this fall.

The work will be in two volumes, and Capt. Ashe hopes to have the second volume ready about one year from time the first volume is out. The first volume will include the period of landing of white men on the coast of what is now North Carolina to the opening of the Revolutionary war. The second volume will cover the period from the Revolution to the present time. Capt. Ashe has been gathering material for a history of North Carolina for several years.

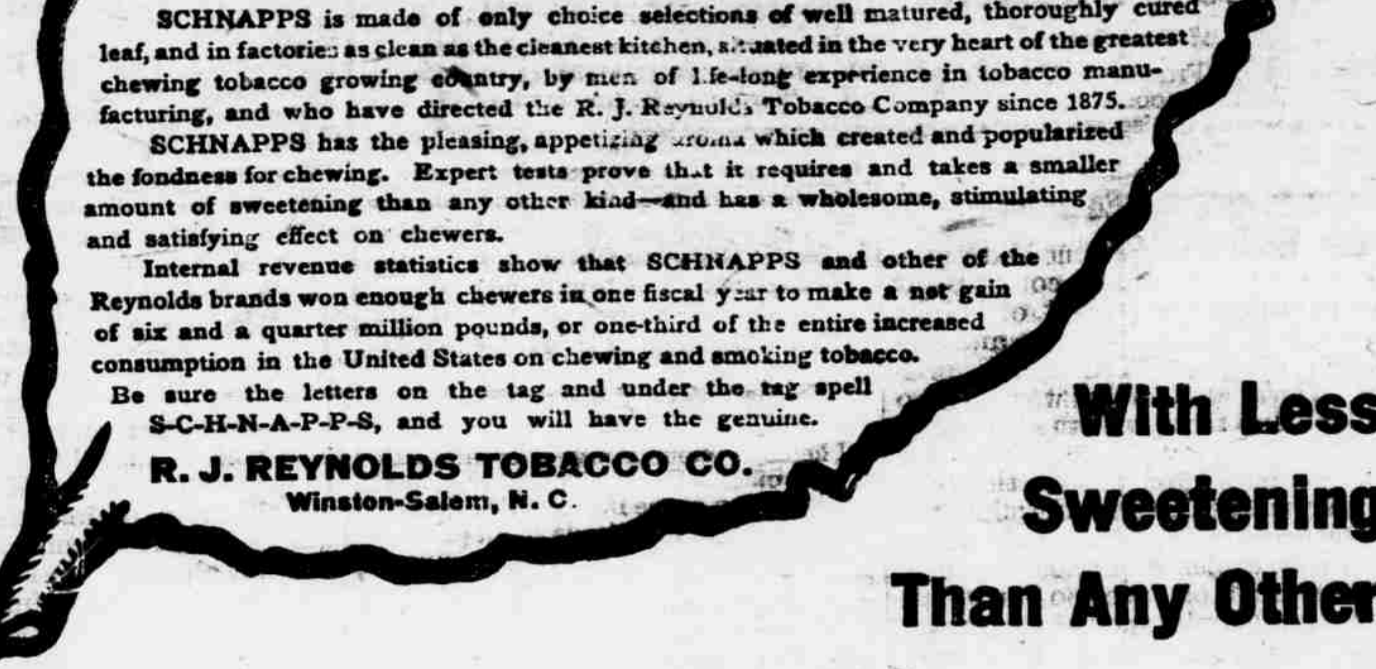
