The Pauper Counties.

We are printing below an interview with the State Auditor, in which he deprecates, and justly so, the fact that some of the wealthy counties draw from the State for pensions and public schools more money than they pay in taxes.

We have commented on the inequality of tax assessments before. But we believe some of these same counties that are dodging their share of taxation, are systematically imposing on the State.

Raleigh special to Greensboro Industrial News. In his report to Governor Glenn and the General Assembly, State Auditor B. F. Dixon emphasizes the fact that there are in the State forty-five counties which receive more money from the State treasury in school appropriations and pensions for soldiers than these counties put into the State in taxes.

He says there is no excuse, for instance, for the great county of Cumberland to be a burden to the State in that this county receives from the State for schools and pensions \$4,000 more than it pays State taxes.

Mr. Dixon says there are some few sparsely settled and remote counties with some excuse for being a burden to the State, but that the great majority of the forty-five need a readjustment of valuations so that the citizenship, amply able, shall bear their proportion of the burden of the State taxation.
