

that on appeal in criminal cases no new trial shall be granted for the admission or exclusion of incompetent testimony for erroneous instructions by the judge below or for any mistake in pleading or the bill of indictment, unless judge of the higher court is satisfied that there has been a "miscarriage of justice. This would be placing an enormous power in the hands of oppellate judges and would amount to setting aside some of the very fundamental principles of the constitution and the Bill of Rights.
