



Although several pleaded with him not to burn it, he would not listen to them. None present seemed to be afraid nor rend their garments, for were they not in the presence of the king and therefore safe in indorsing what he did? Besides, a king who would send into Egypt for a prophet in order to kill him might not hesitate to kill some of

them if they stood against him. If we live in the fear of the Lord we will not fear the face of man nor what man may do unto us, but the devil has said, "All that a man hath will he give up for his life" (Job ii, 4), and that is true of many of the devil's people, but should not be true of any child of God.
