Obituary

Daniel Edwin Moose was born in Stanley County, N. C. May 20, 1864, and departed this life May 8, 1912, aged 48 years and 18 days. Jan. 13, 1876 he united in marriage with Miss Anna Eliza Link, and to this union 9 children were born, three of whom preceded their father to the glorious beyond. He has been a resident of Hickory for 28 years and for 25 years a member of Holy Trinity Lutheran church.

As a citizen he identified himself with every movement for good and walked uprightly before his fellow men. As a Christian and member of Holy Trinity he conducted himself as a Christian gentleman and took an active part in the affairs of the church so long as his health permitted. Like every one of us he had his faults, but also his virtues. For none of us that doeth good sinneth not.
