Old Sickness Said the Wrong Thing.

One of Col. Roosevelt's fool friends was about to get him in hot water. Gen. Daniel E. Sickles, of New York, at the meeting for organizing the new Progressive party in New York, said that Woodrow Wilson was "born amid rebel surroundings, and that we of the North have never been disposed to put such a man in the White House."
