Mr. Charles Daniels of Wilson introduced a resolution urging the Governor, Attorney General and Freight Rate Association to examine into the facts of the case, with the view to annulling the charters of every railroad in the State that exacted tribute of the State by means of excessive o. discriminatory freight charges. but this resolution was ordered b. the Resolutions Committee to be filed with the secretary of the as-


