**Newspapers Criticise the Japanese Cabinet.**

Tokio, July 28.—Some of the leading Japanese newspapers today accuse the Japanese cabinet of lack of diplomatic adroitness in the negotiations connected with the California alien land ownership legislation. They argue that advantage should be taken of Mexico's friendliness in order to further Japan's cause. At the same time they question the sincerity of the United States.

M. Hashimoto, vice minister of commerce, made the following statement today in connection with Japanese participation in the Panama Pacific exposition:

"The authorities understand that it is reasonable for Japan merchants to refuse to exhibit at the Panama Pacific exposition owing to their natural aversion against the alien land ownership bill, but such participation would ease the situation and the Japanese government hopes that the nation will send as many exhibits as possible."
