correspondent at Verdun. "I say to you that the Old Guard of Napoleon Bonaparte was not so great as my army of Verdun." As great as were Napoleon's veterans, they could not match the courage of the French soldiers at Verdun, who saw themselves being forced back by yards, feet and inches, and then from a defending army became an attacking army and recaptured in a single night what they had yielded in four months. These are the men whom the Germans declared were "bled to death." Yet they struck with such force that the whole world was surprised. The soldiers of Verdun, both French and German, are brave men, but the world will crown the French as the greater heroes. WANT THEIR DEMANDS

Why should the railway brotherhoods not feel that because congress gave them the eight-hour day, no higher authority should be allowed to pass on the question.
