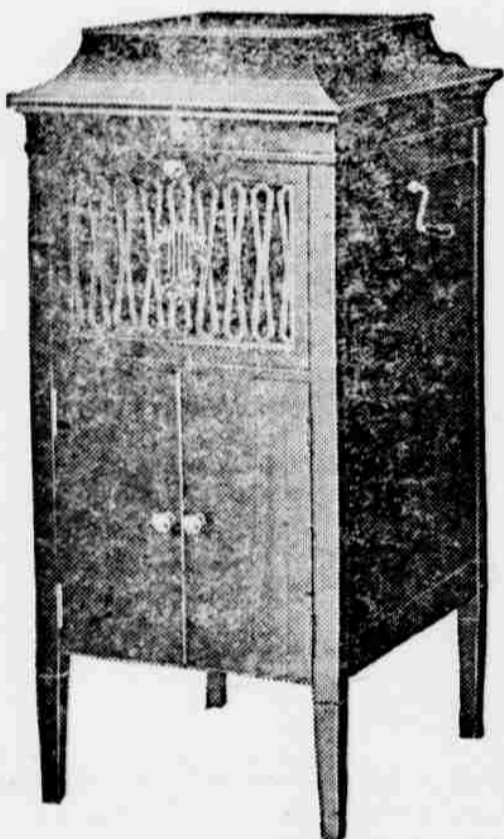

If a majority of the qualified voters at the election to be held on the date hereinafter mentioned shall vote in favor of said tax, the same shall be expended exclusively for the maintenance of schools within said district.

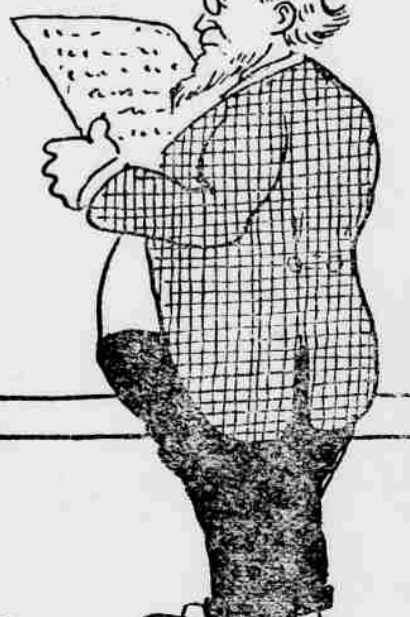
