Springfield, Mo., June 11.—A mob of Springfield citizens, bent on avenging the murder of 14 months old Lloyd Keet early Sunday forced Sheriff Webb to give up six suspects, swung one of them to a tree for some time in an unsuccessful attempt to obtain a confession, and later returned them to the sheriff's custody.

MARKED INCREASE NOTED IN POULTRY IN STORAGE

Washington, June 11.—Cold storage houses held 54,834,191 pounds of frozen poultry June 1, 487 per cent, or nearly five times greater than a year ago, according to a department of agriculture report.

PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT PRACTICES ECONOMY

Manila, P. I., June 11.—War economy for the Philippine Islands has had its first exemplification in a sweeping executive order issued by Governor General Harrison advising every government employe to exercise unusual care in the consumption of supplies.

This step is the first taken by the government to impress upon its employes the necessity for wartime economy though the heads of departments have been practicing it for two years.

Large in consequence of war circumstances, the Holland markets are being eliminated in a number of cases. For instance, one or two important purchases of tobacco for America have been made here recently instead of, as usual, at the Amsterdam auction sales.

JAVA'S EXPORTS TO AMERICA INCREASED

Pavaria, Netherlands, East Indies.—The value of Java's exports to America in the first quarter of 1917 exceeded that of the entire export in the year 1916.

Japan, as well as America, is keenly alive to the commercial possibilities of the country and, in the enforced absence of German and other competitors, Japanese trade is rapidly extending.

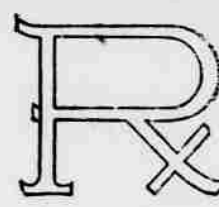

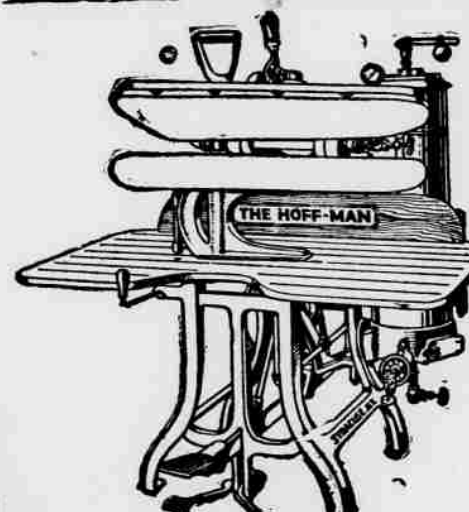

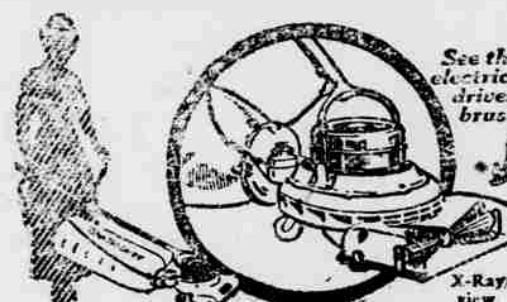
