RUSSIAN DESTROYER SINKS SUBMARINE

Petrograd, July 19.—The North and South Agency reports that a Russian destroyer has sunk a German submarine in the Baltic by dropping bombs on it and that the crew of the submarine was drowned.

London, July 19.—Fourteen British ships of over 1,600 tons were sunk by submarines or mine in the last week, according to the official report last night. Four British vessels under 1,600 tons were sunk and eight fishing vessels.

The official report follows: "Arrivals, 2,828; sailings, 2,929. "British merchant ships sunk by mine or submarine, over 1,600 tons, including one previously, 14; under 1,600 tons, four. "British merchant vessels unsuccessfully attacked, including three previously, 12. "British fishing vessels sunk, eight."

The admiralty report of the previous week announced the sinking of 14 vessels of over 1,600 tons and three of less than 1,600 tons. The fishing vessels lost numbered seven.

U. S. INVITED TO ATTEND CONFERENCE

Washington, July 19.—The United States has been officially invited by the allied governments to participate in the allied conference to be held in Paris sometime this month, but has decided that for the present it will not be necessary.

It was officially explained at the state department that while the course was to be followed for the present it was not to be taken as the general policy of the United States.
