SOLDIERS INSURANCE BEING WORKED OUT

Washington, July 24.—Basic fundamentals of the government's plan for insuring men of the army, navy and marine corps against death and injury were being worked out today by federal officers assisted by representatives of the country's leading insurance companies. As soon as details can be completed the draft will be submitted to President Wilson for his approval.


The program provides government allowance for families of men in the service and the training of soldiers and sailors to equip them for service after the war.
