ENFORCE AUTOMOBILE LAW Notice is hereby given that section 13 of the state automobile law will be enforced. The section follows: "Sec. 13. ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF WATER WORKS BONDS

"Whereas, the public health and convenience require the improvement and extension of the water works system of the "City of Hickory"; "Now, therefore, be it ordained: "That the "City Council of the City of Hickory" finds the following facts:

(a) That the city treasurer has filed with the city manager, ex-officio city clerk, a statement of the debt of the "City of Hickory," pursuant to the "Municipal Finance Act of 1917," and that said statement is now in the office of the city manager and is open to public inspection.

(b) That the average assessed valuation of property subject to taxation by the "City of Hickory" for the years nineteen hundred fifteen and nineteen hundred sixteen is two million, one hundred eighty-one thousand, six hundred forty-two dollars, and sixty six and two thirds cents (\$2,181,642.66 2-3), as is shown by said statement.

(c) That the average assessed valuation of property subject to taxation by the "City of Hickory" for the years nineteen hundred fifteen, nineteen hundred sixteen and nineteen hundred seventeen is two million, two hundred ninety-six thousand, two hundred forty-nine dollars and thirty-three and one-third cents, (\$2,296,249.33 1-3), as is shown by said statement, and that the years nineteen hundred fifteen, nineteen hundred sixteen and nineteen hundred seventeen are the three fiscal years in which taxes were last levied.

(d) That the amount of the net debt of the "City of Hickory" outstanding, authorized and to be authorized (including all proposed bonds) is two hundred two thousand, eight hundred forty-three dollars (\$202,843.00), as is shown by said statement.

"That water works bonds of the maximum principal amount of fifteen thousand dollars, bearing a maximum rate of interest of five per centum per annum, be and are hereby authorized to be issued by the "City of Hickory," a municipal corporation in Catawba county, State of North Carolina, for the purpose of constructing additional service mains and for other additional extensions and improvements of the water works system, of said municipal corporation, except service connections.

"That the maximum period within which the said water works bonds shall mature is and shall be thirty years, the probable period of the usefulness of the improvement aforesaid.
