ENFORCE AUTOMOBILE LAW

Notice is hereby given that section 13 of the state automobile law will be enforced. The section follows: "Sec. 13. That no person shall operate a motor vehicle upon the public highways of this state who is under the age of sixteen years and who is not competent physically and mentally, and no person shall operate a motor vehicle when intoxicated, or in a race, or on a bet or wager, or for the purpose of making a speed record; Provided, nothing herein contained shall prevent racing on private race courses or tracks."
