SANITARY ORDINANCE TO PROTECT HEALTH.

The following is the ordinance adopted by city council in regard to sewer connections and sanitary closets:

Section 1. That all owners, tenants and occupants of all houses, tenements and buildings situated within the fire limits or on any lot or lots more distant from a street, block or square abutting on such street, avenue or alley, shall connect all closets, privies, sinks and urinals with such sewer, within 90 days after service of notice from the city manager to give such notice to such owners, tenants and occupants at once, or whenever any sewer is hereafter laid and is ready for use.

Section 2. That, after the expiration of the time stipulated in the notice above provided, it shall be unlawful for the owner, tenant or occupant of any such house, tenement or building to keep or maintain any surface closets, sinks, cesspools, or urinals, upon any such lot, or in any house, tenement or building thereon.

Section 3. That it shall be unlawful for the owner, tenant or occupant of any such house, tenement or building, any part of which is used as a residence or for business purposes during any portion of the day or night, to fail to have at least one water closet connected with the sewer within sixty days after the passage of this ordinance; that this section shall be construed as requiring one water closet for each house, tenement or building situated as aforesaid.

Section 4. That the owner of every dwelling house or place where persons live, which is not required to be connected with the sewer system, shall provide the person occupying the same with a sanitary privy. By a sanitary privy, wherever it occurs in this ordinance is meant a receptacle for human excrement that is enclosed in such a way that it is absolutely fly proof.

Section 5. That it shall be the duty of the City Manager to have prepared plans and specifications for sanitary privies, copies of which shall be kept on file in his office for public inspection; and when such plans and specifications are prepared and filed as aforesaid, a notice of that fact shall be published in two issues of one or more of the papers published within the city; and it shall be unlawful for any person to have upon his premises or those occupied by him any privy that does not conform to the plans and specifications so prepared and filed, at any time after the expiration of a period of Ninety (90) days from the first publication of such notice.
