It was not uncommon, said the speaker to have a soldier come to him at pay day and handing him some money, tell him to make out a money order as quickly as possible before he could change his mind. he boys soon come to realize their weakness and want to overcome it.

This speaks volumes for the influence of the army Y. M. C. A.
