### WEATHER UNFAVORABLE FOR THE COTTON CROP

Washington, Aug. 22.—Weather generally unfavorable for development of cotton during the last week in most of the belt, the national weather and crop bulletin announced yesterday. The statement continues: "West of the Mississippi river little or no relief occurred from the serious drought that has caused much damage to the crop in that section, and to the eastward conditions continued unsatisfactory in many localities. The rains at the close of the week, however, in many sections of the eastern portion of the belt where moisture had been deficient were very beneficial and will give at

least temporary relief. "The crop made slow progress in North Carolina the first part of the week, but good rains were very helpful the latter part, while in South Carolina good to excellent advance was made in the central and north portions but rather poor in the coastal plain section. Progress was generally unsatisfactory in Georgia, except in portions of the south where good rains occurred, and many complaints of rust and spider damage continue in that state. Development was satisfactory in most places in Tennessee, Alabama and Mississippi, with rather pronounced deterioration in parts of Mississippi. "The crop ranges from fair to good in Louisiana, and while light to moderate showers occurred at many

points in Arkansas, moisture continues insufficient and development of the crop is generally unsatisfactory in that state. Bolls are small and continue to open prematurely in Oklahoma and the outlook is generally poor, while growth has ceased with general complaint of shedding and too early opening in Texas. Picking is well advanced in Texas and is becoming general in the coast sections to the eastward. This work has begun as far north as Oklahoma."

### STEAMER MONTANAN IS SUNK BY SUBMARINE

Washington, Aug. 22.—The American steamer Montanan of 6,650 tons gross, was torpedoed and sunk in foreign waters August 16 with the probable loss of three members of the civilian crew and two members of the naval armed guard, the navy department last night announced. Eighty-one survivors were landed. The Montanan was in the service of the quartermaster's department of the army and was used as a supply ship. The members of the naval guard reported as missing are David W. Johnson, coxswain and Chester C. Eldridge, seaman. The names of the civilian members of the crew unaccounted for have not been ascertained. The navy department's announcement follows: "The navy department is informed that the steamship Montanan was torpedoed and sunk in foreign waters on August 16. Every one of the survivors were landed. Five men are reported missing—three members of the civilian crew and two of the naval armed guard, David W. Johnson, coxswain, and Chester C. Eldridge, seaman. The names of the three civilians were not given in the

dispatches received. "The Montanan was an American cargo ship of 6,650 gross tons."
