LLOYD GEORGE'S SPEECH Springfield Republican.

Many difficult corners have been turned by Lloyd George in the course of his remarkable political career, but perhaps his adroitness has never been put to a severer test than he faces in the session of parliament which opened yesterday. A detailed examination of his speech may wait upon a fuller report than has come to hand, but the passages available give the impression that he has used the very multiplicity of the questions clamoring for discussion to furnish an excuse for postponing or slighting the most awkward of them.

He was not at all happy in his treatment of the Irish question, transferring to it the logic chopping methods by which he has in the past contributed to what he has called the Russian fog. Unless England was ready to sanction an Irish republic, talk of self-determination, he said was "dishonest." And quite in his former Russian style he rhetorically demanded whether the government should withdraw all its troops and "leave the assassins in charge in Ireland." There was a time when he thought it impossible to make peace with the assassins in Moscow, but now he realizes that in the case of Russia the best cure for assassination is peace, and he may come to the same view in regard to Ireland.

A demand by labor leaders and others for the revision of the treaty of Versailles the premier seems to have passed over in his speech, but upon Russia, a subject which British labor has much at heart, he spoke at some length. Bolshevism, he said, could not be crushed by force of arms, and the so-called "ring of fire" was impracticable; the Baltic states were already making peace: "We failed to restore Russia to sanity by force; I believe we can save her by trade. Incidentally "Europe badly needs what Russia is able to supply but cannot supply with contending armies moving across her borders." On the whole Lloyd George's new Russian policy does not seem the most serious of his troubles; with business interests and the powerful labor party supporting it successful opposition is unlikely.
