LABOR FIGHTING! W. ADVOCATE REPORTS HIS DISCHARGE

Washington, Jan. 26.—Organized labor reported dissatisfied with the recommendations of the state text book commission for books to be used in elementary grades for the next three years.

The complaint of the union for a long time past part of the commission's report which gave preference over union publishers' preference over non-union company, one of the latter being the John W. Winsor Company of Minneapolis. It is being charged

the next book commission sides with "readers" which some of the non-union publishers submitted and quoted in their stead similar books chosen by non-union companies.

Books, of course, have not yet

been adopted, but merely recommended by the commission.

Complaint of the organized labor is in the nature of an appeal to the commission to the council of state which meets February 6 to consider the adoption. But the books recommended will select must be taken from the list submitted by the text book commission. The council of state is not bound by the suggestions which gives the non-union publishers precedence over the union companies, however.

Letters of protest will be sent by

one of the labor leaders to members

of the council of state urging an

"improve deal" for the union publishers.

Whether this protest

will have any weight with the govern-

ment is a question, but it will

make a noise.

It does not appear whether the un-

ion forces in the state are satisfied

with the great number of changes

in text books the commission has

recommended for the next three-five

year adoption, but generally speaking

there is heard dissatisfaction with

the new books.

A questionnaire is now being mailed

out by Secretary A. T. Allen to all

members of the North Carolina

Teachers Assembly asking them to

give their preference on three possi-

bility dates for the 1922 meeting of

the assembly.

The dates suggested are as fol-

lows: October 25-27; November 21-

December 1; December 27-29. The

first date comes about one month

earlier than previous meetings, while

the second is the old Thanksgiving

week date on which all of the as-

sembly meetings have been held in

the past. The third date comes in

the Christmas holidays.

A majority vote will determine the

1922 date.
