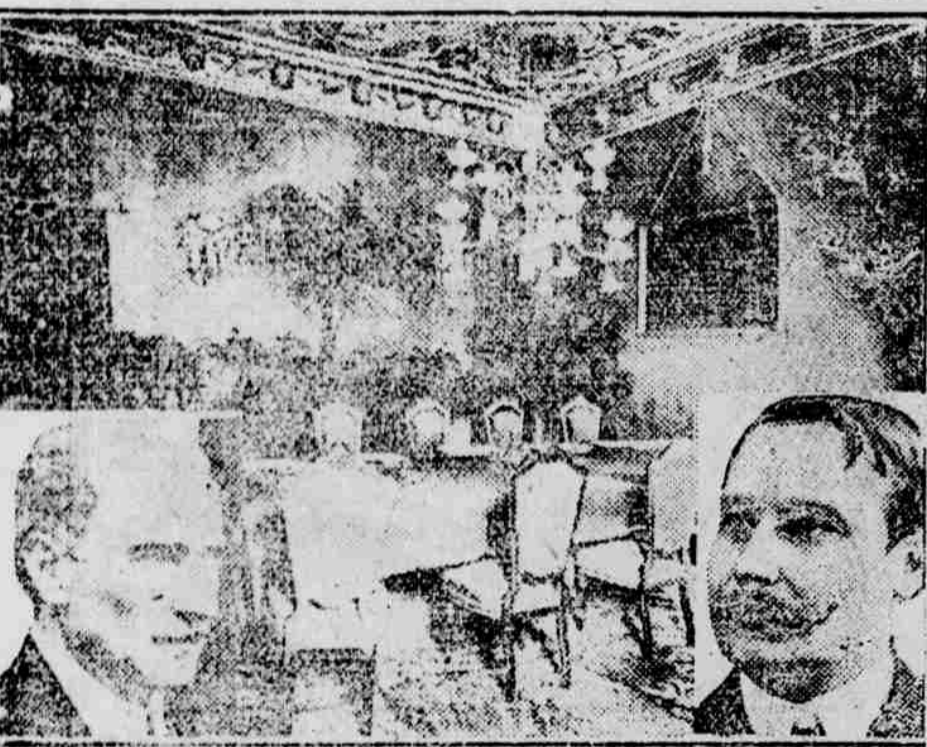


Wilson As He Looks Today

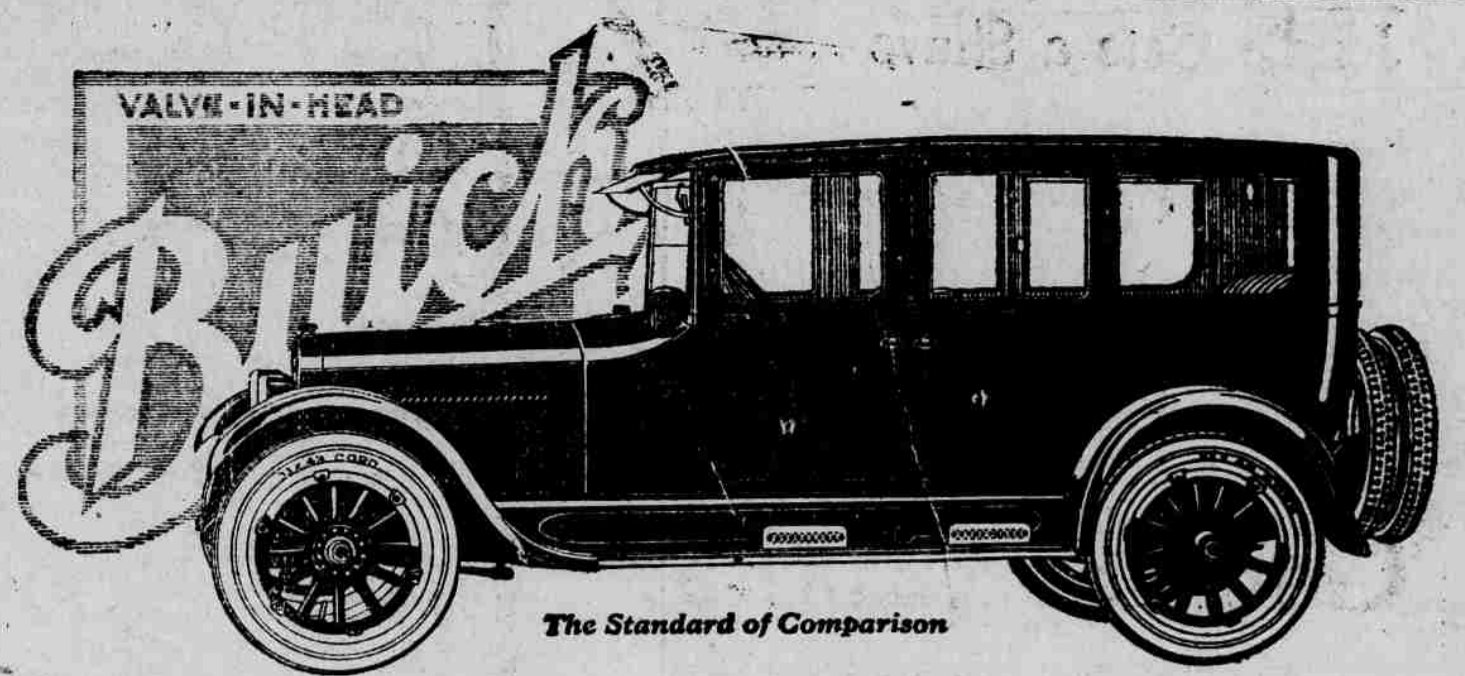

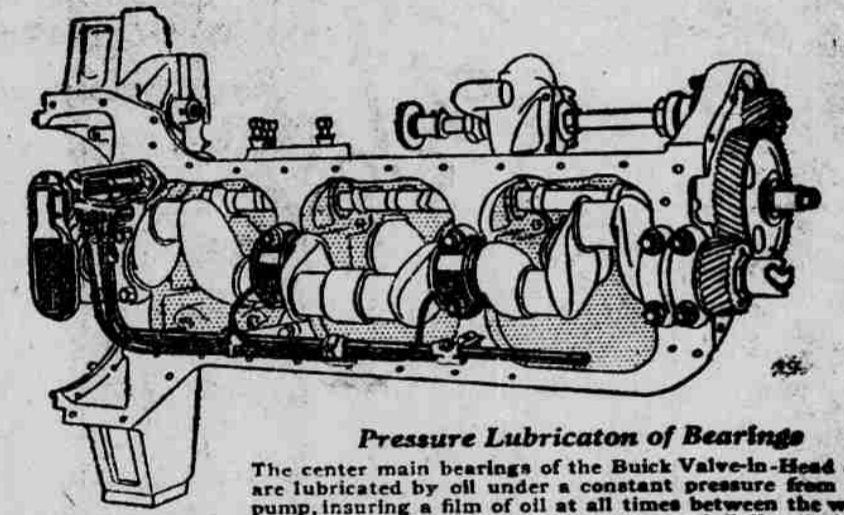
