THE SCHOOL ELECTION.
Cary, N. C., Aug. 10.—Cary township: Vote for school tax. For tax 123, against 105.
Anson County.
Wadeboro, Aug. 10.—Returns from the different townships of this county so far heard from at this hour indicate a large majority against schools.

Northampton against tax.
Rich Square, Aug. 10.—All returns not in, but indications are all the township in Northampton will vote against the special school tax by large majorities.
Lumberton Against tax.
Lumberton, Aug. 10.—Lumberton precinct votes 72 for school tax, 180 against. Information from county townships indicate that the whole county has voted largely against schools.

In Moore County.
Sanford, Aug. 10.—Very little interest was shown in the supplementary school tax election held here to-day. Of the three hundred voters in the township 143 voted at this election; 132 voted against and 11 for the measure.

Franklin Against Tax.
Franklin, Aug. 10.—The vote at this precinct is 79 for, 82 against the school tax. It was thought the other two precincts in this township would go against the tax. At ten o'clock at Louisville only four out of 56 votes had been given for the tax.

New Hanover Against.
Wilmington, Aug. 10.—Very meagre returns of the election held to-day on the question of additional taxation for public schools fully sustain the forecast given in these dispatches last night. The vote so far as received is almost unanimously against the tax. In some precincts not a single vote was cast in its favor.

HAVE QUIT MARRYING.
If one may judge by return of the unlisted taxables made to the State Auditor by the Sheriff of Buncombe, there was not a marriage in that county last year. The price of a marriage license is \$2. Of this the State gets \$1. The sheriff of Buncombe does not return anything for this item. The Auditor thing it is an oversight and has written to have it corrected.—
