BRITISH-GERMAN COMBINE TO CONTROL DYE BUSINESS

(By Associated Press)

London, Feb. 28.—A new combination which will control the dye production of the world has been formed between the British Dyestuffs Corporation and the Interessens Gemeinschaft, the German dye combine. Under the agreement the German secret processes are to be revealed to the British company for an agreed share of the profits.

The British Dyestuffs Corporation, of which the government is the largest stockholder, now controls the British markets and will be extended to foreign countries.

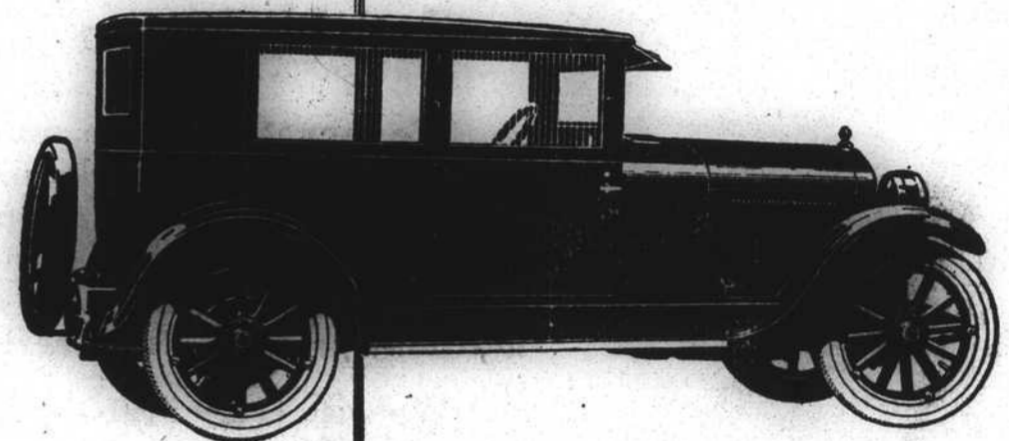
