TERRIBLE MINE DISASTER.

One Hundred and Fifty-Four Men Lose Their Lives by Fire Damp.

Hanna, Wyo., June 30.—Hanna was the scene of a terrible disaster at 10:30 a. m., when an explosion of fire damp in mine No. 1 of the Union Pacific Coal Company, resulted in the lives of 154 men, injured scores of others and caused the destruction of a vast amount of property. The mine was not fired, as was stated in the earlier reports, but the explosion was a typical one, caused by the failure of the main shaft air supply, which allowed the fire damp to enter the mine, and then to the miners that were not killed outright by the explosion were killed by the fire damp.

COTTON MARKET CORNERED.

One Man Buys 100,000 Bales, Paying 13 Cents per Pound.

New York, June 28.—In their report of the cotton market C. W. Lee & Co. say: "These are historic making days. Notices for about 100,000 bales of cotton in black were issued today, which simply means that one man took from another 100,000 bales of cotton at 13 cents a pound, or \$130,000 a bale, or a total of \$13,000,000. This is believed to be by far the largest individual transaction in the cotton market of the country. Not only this, but for the first time in the history of the cotton production, one man has bought more than one-half of the total supply of cotton in the country."

The Smallest on Record.

Henry Folger has the distinction of having issued the smallest money order on record, so far as we are aware. Some days ago a seely looking individual with a sour voice appeared at the money order window and called for an application blank. It was handed him and Postmaster Folger was astonished to find that the order called for one cent. It was made to a member of a well known Atlanta printing firm. The order was mailed, but sometime after Mr. Folger received an enquiry from the Atlanta Postmaster to know what to do as the order had never been presented for payment.
