To the Taxpayers of Union County, North Carolina: Under the Revaluation Act as passed by the General Assembly of North Carolina, session of 1919, all personal property will have to be listed as of the first day of January. I hereby notify all taxpayers to make an inventory of all personal property on the first day of January, 1920, in order that they may know what property they had at that time. Merchants must take stock on the first of January so as to know what amount of stock they had on hand together with the amount of open accounts due them. I would suggest that all taxpayers take stock of all corn, wheat, oats, fodder, cotton baled and in seed, meat, lard, flour, and all provisions, live stock, wagons, buggies, automobiles, farming implements and all other property including money on hand and in bank and any moneys that may be due them in order that they may be able to make intelligent returns of what they have on the first of January, 1920. The personal property will be listed by appointments in the different townships as hereinafter. The places and times for listing personal property will be advertised hereafter for the different townships, so as to let the taxpayers know where to meet me and my assistants.
