EXTORTION BY DOCTORS

Doctors in the large towns of the two Carolinas, following the example of Baltimore and New York physicians, have adopted a unique scheme for extorting fees from patients, which for viciousness, is seldom equalled in the other professions. Taking advantage of the mental condition of a patient, they send him to their friends, who are specilists in other lines, for examination, and before he knows whether he is a desperately ill person, or a victim of his imagination, the patient has paid \$10 to each specialist in the circle. A good practitioner, in the beginning, could have diagnosed his trouble without exposing his purse to further' inroads.

Many of these doctors do charity work, but their collections from wellto-do patients more than offset their, loss for this kind of work.

There are general practitioners in Monroe who could make as good, if not better, examinations of afflicted persons than these doctors in the large cities if they only had the necessary equipment. It is proposed to furnish them this equipment at the Ellen Fitzgerald hospital, but from the delays that are being experienced it looks like scores of Union county people will be victimized by the medical circles of large cities before it is completed.


