FAMOUS POLITICIAN HAS

Comes Out Into Political Arena Af-ter Retirement of 25 Years—His First Race Famona.

LEAD OVER GOV. ROBERTS

ter Retirement of 25 Years—His First Race Famous.

Nashville, Tenn., Nov 3—After being in political retirement for twenty-five years, and with more than a third of a century between his first and second race for governor. Alfred Alexander Taylor, familiarly known as "Alf" Taylor, waged a vigorous campaign.

Mr. Taylor was past the three score and ten mark when he entered the race for the Republican nomination in the primary of August 5 last. In the beginning many Tennezsceaus who knew him simply as the brother of "Our Bob," late Democratic Governor and Senator from Tennessee, looked upon his campaign as hardly a matter for serious consideration. This view underwent a change when Colonel Taylor took the stump and began an active campaign. It became evident that it was a one man's race practically all over the State. So "Alf" Taylor woke up on his seventy-second birthday to find himself the Ropublican nominee for Governor of Tennessee for the Reosca."

Taylor's first race for Governor was the most famous affair of the kind in the history of the State. On

On June 18, 1886, the Republican State convention met in Nashville, and the late Richard W. Austin, for several terms Congressman from the second Tennessee district, nominated Taylor for Governor.

The Democratic state convention met on August 11, 1886, and after considerable jockeying, nominated Robert L. Taylor, "Our Bob," for Governor on the fifteenth ballot, Thus it was that Tennessee's "War of the Roses" was set going.

The iwo Taylors made a tour of the The jwo Taylors made a tour of the State, speaking to immense crowds. They hammered the opposition party and poked fun it one another, but wound up each day with brotherly affection unimpaired. After a tour of the Sequathie Valley, in the course of the campaign, the two stopped at Bridgeport, Ala., for the night as guests of a Mrs. Jones, who had heard them speak that afternoon at Jasper. The good woman was great-
