Doctor Barrett has made a wonderful impression upon the intelligent and thinking minds of Greensboro. From the first he has endeavored to reconcile God's doings with man and his requirements of man with the principles of right and justice. "Shall not the God of all the earth do right?" Doctor Barrett has travelled all over the world and associated with the leaders of religions through in all countries and he draws the most beautiful and striking illustrations from the incidents occurring in his travels. He is intimate with Cannon Farrar, and while he differs with this great preacher in some things he esteems him a great man and a good man—his errors spring out of the benevolence of his nature.

Doctor Barrett's broadness commands him to popular favor; while he is firm in his own convictions, he records perfect charity and civility to all who differ with him. One thing is remarkable, not a harsh word or a vicious sentiment or a fervent thought has found expression from his lips. He loves all mankind. In his private study he practices most graciously, and the simplicity and modesty of his manners are as loving and pure as a little child.

It is wonderful that so great a mind, one so full of knowledge, is so ready to listen with patience to the humblest visitor that approaches him. He is so pure, so gentle, so kind, that we lose the embarrassment at once with which we approach him.
