But Nogi was a genuine man and soldier, well poised and intellectually strong—therefore the last act of his life is entitled to respectful analysis and consideration. It were easy to conclude that he was a superstitious barbarian, who committed felo de se in compliance with the traditions of a barbaric race. But such a conclusion is not justified by the present state of civilization of the Japanese race. A man of his character and antecedents must have had a reason for his act, other than the mere following of a custom hallowed by time.—Va Pilot.
