\$500,000 In Bonds

A resolution was introduced in the Senate at Raleigh by Senator Long for four per cent State bonds to meet \$500,000 of the deficit caused by the expenditure of that amount in round figures for permanent improvements at the State institutions and \$75,000 for equipping and heating the new State building and an amount necessary for rear-ranging the old Supreme Court building for other State departments and to provide for covering into the State Treasury the \$217,000 standing to the credit of the Penitentiary.

Inaugural Parade.

The military feature of the inaugural parade practically has been completed, according to the announcement by Maj. Gen. Leonard Wood, grand marshal. Present figures indicate that there will be nearly 25,000 soldiers and sailors from the regular and State militia services in line.

Robert N. Harper, chairman of the civic organizations committee, told the inaugural committee that at least 15,000 marchers would be in his section of the parade. This will be composed of political clubs and old organizations of a semi-political nature. In this section also will be the Governors and their staffs from States that will not be represented by militia. Governors of at least 20 States are expected to be in the line of march.

Source of the Brahmaputra.
For 40 years the birthplace of the great Brahmaputra river of India was thought to be among the high valleys of the eastern Himalayas or on the Plateau of Tibet north of those mountains. The theory could not be proved, for hostile Abors in the Himalayan valleys killed the explorers or barred their way when they sought to solve the mystery.

It was believed 20 years ago that the Sangpo river, flowing far eastward through southern Tibet, was the upper part of the Brahmaputra. Marked on a map set afloat in the Sangpo were watched for in the Brahmaputra, but were never found. At last, however, the explorers sent out with the troops who have punished the Abhors for their massacre of Williamson and his 100 carriers have shown that the two rivers are identical. The Brahmaputra rises far west near the headwaters of the Indus, among the mountains bordering southern Tibet.
